GENERAL INFORMATION

A SASA Level 2 licence MD/LA2/002/JUN10 has been issued and accreditation will be applied for. The meet will be swum under SASA / FINA rules.

All swimmers must be registered with and have a SASA registration number

- AGE GROUPS** 10 years, 11 years & 12 years (as on day of competition)
- POOL** 6 lane 25 metre, anti-turbulence lane ropes, electronic timing.
Over the top starts may be used where deemed suitable.
- WARM-UP** **SESSION 1** Warm up 0915 - 1015. Start 1020
SESSION 2 Warm up 1400 - 1500. Start 1505
- ENTRIES** Closing date Sunday 9th May 2010.
No late entries will be accepted.
The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of heats and alter the warm up times if required.
Reserves may be picked on the day, in the first instance this will be from any oversubscribed DCA swimmers.
Entries will be by Hytek file only. Please apply for an entry file and further information to m.j.simpson@btinternet.com
Entries will NOT be accepted for composite teams.
- EVENTS** 10 and 11 year old events are swum over 50m (except the I.M.) and 12 year old events will all be swum over 100m. All events will have finals which shall run at the end of each session except Individual Medleys which will be heat declared winners.
- RELAYS** Relay teams shall be made up from a girl and a boy from each of the three age groups (6 swimmers). Swimmers may swim in any order. The relay will be heat declared winners. The relay may be limited to two heats.
- SEEDING** The 3 fastest heats will be CYCLICALLY seeded for all events except 100m IM and Relays which will be DECK seeded.
- AWARDS** **Individual Medals 1st, 2nd, 3rd**
Relay Team Medals 1st, 2nd, 3rd (Qualifying Teams ONLY).
BEST BOY, BEST GIRL, BEST CLUB TROPHY.
Points scoring shall be 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point for all events.
- WITHDRAWALS** Withdrawals should be made via email to m.j.simpson@btinternet.com prior to the day of the meet.
On the day withdrawals must be made at the Recorders table by 15mins after the start of the session warm up i.e. 0930 & 1415.
- FEES** £4.50 per individual event, £8.00 per relay team.

**COACHES
INFORMATION**

Coaches will be issued with a Poolside Pass which must be displayed at all times whilst on poolside. Due to limited poolside space, the number of coaches per team will be limited to a maximum of 1 coach for teams with fewer than 10 swimmers and a maximum of 2 coaches for teams with more than 10 swimmers. Clubs may request additional coach poolside passes by email to the Gala Convenor clearly stating valid reasons for such requests. Please note that coaches should make their own arrangements for lunches. Full café facilities are available within Olympia.

PARKING

Car parking facilities are available at the Olympia Centre. Short / Long Term car parks are available. Dundee City Aquatics has no control over these or the charges.
Note that parking charges are in effect from 1300 onwards on Sundays.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Due to warnings issued by the SASA we are obliged to inform you that the use of photographic equipment (cameras, camcorders, mobile phones incorporating cameras etc.) will be restricted as follows:

1. No photographic equipment will be allowed either on poolside or the viewing gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the organising club without the written prior approval of that club.
2. Application to use the above named equipment can be made on the day to the organising clubs' nominated official. Any person wishing to do this must be able to provide identification, and evidence that they have swimmer(s) competing in the gala.
3. Application must be made on the official SASA form.

SWIMSUITS

Swimsuits must comply with FINA/SASA rules in place on the day of the competition.
