Venue: Tollcross Park Leisure Centre, Glasgow, G32 7QR

Pool 10 lane x 50 metres with full electronic timing with warm-up and swim down facilities.

Age Categories: 11/12 years
13/14 years
15/16 years
17 & over
Open (no age stipulation)

Age is as on first day of the competition

Events: The programme for each age category will be as follows:

11/12 years	100m on each of the 4 strokes
13/14 years	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
15/16 years	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
17 & over	100m and 200m on each of the 4 strokes
Open	200m IM and “50m Challenge”

100m events and 200m IM will be Heats and Finals. The remaining 200m events will be Heat Declared Winner.

In the heats, the 15/16 and 17 & over age groups will be combined, with results separated by age group.

“50m Challenge”: The “50m Challenge” is a knockout freestyle event. From the morning heats, ten swimmers will progress to the first knockout stage held at the beginning of the afternoon session. Four swimmers progress to the second knockout stage at the beginning of the Finals session, and the fastest two swimmers compete in a “head-to-head” at the end of the Finals session. The prize money reflects the expected standard of the event.

Entry Fee: £6.50 per event

Poolside Pass: £10.00 each to cover the duration of the meet and to include pool access. All coaches and other staff who wish to have poolside access must have passes. Each club will receive a programme and set of start sheets per poolside pass purchased. Coffee and tea will be available all day in the Meet Office area for holders of poolside passes. Note that meals are not included in the Pass.

Presentations: Awards as above will be made to the swimmers placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each of the events. The only exception is the “50m Challenge” where awards as above will be made to the swimmers placed 1st & 2nd. Appropriate club clothing should be worn for presentations. Prize-winners, or an appointed depute, must be available for presentation as per the Presentation Schedule, a copy of which will be included in the club envelope and posted around the pool.

Session Times: The session times will be as follows:

Entry Times: There are no consideration times, but the organisers reserve the right to make cuts to ensure a balanced programme and the smooth running of the meet. Entry times will be long course times, however short course times converted to long course are acceptable.

Starts / Finishes: During the heats, over the top starts will be used for all events except backstroke. For finals, swimmers must leave the pool by the far side steps.

Entries: Entries should be submitted by the closing date using Hy-Tek Team Manager and the events file provided. Please ensure that it

is completed correctly to show the **FULL NAME OF SWIMMER, FULL DATE OF BIRTH, REGISTRATION NUMBER and ENTRY TIME**. The Events File will be supplied to clubs on request, along with a full set of instructions if required. Files can be requested by email to Jbruce2160@aol.com. General Information:

- ◆ Competition accreditation will be sought and a licence has been obtained from the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association.
- ◆ The Main Pool will be available for warm-up prior to the start of each session. This time may be split to allow suitable water time and space for all age groupings.
- ◆ During the competition, the swim down pool will be available for ongoing warm up / swim down although the organisers reserve the right to withdraw use of the pool if it is being abused.
- ◆ For the safety of spectators, swimmers must not use the gallery stairways or top corridor when wearing wet swimsuits or without appropriate dry footwear.
- ◆ The organisers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries they accept.

Event Regulations

Entry and Entries to all events is expressly subject to each and all of these regulations and may, where appropriate, also require compliance with the facility provider's regulations:

- Permission for any person to enter or to remain within the venue notwithstanding possession of any ticket by that person is at the absolute discretion of the stewards and officers of the East District and/or any police officer.
- No guarantee can be given by the East District that the event will take place at a particular time or any particular date and East District reserves the right to reschedule the event without notice and without any liability for so doing.
- In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the event, refunds if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of the East District. The East District will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel and accommodation costs.
- The following are articles, which must not be brought within the venue (glasses, fireworks, smoke canisters, air horns, flares, glass bottles, weapons of any sort). Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry at the absolute discretion of any steward or officer of the East District and/or police officer.
- No object may be thrown by spectators within the venue.
- No foul or abusive language or other offensive words such as racial or sexual abuse may be used within venues.
- No alcohol may be consumed within events except in those areas specifically designated for such purposes and in accordance with any terms displayed in those areas.
- No person may for commercial purposes take photographs or use any video recording equipment inside events without the express written permission of the East District. The taking of photographs or use of video equipment for non-commercial purposes is permitted subject to compliance with SASA Ltd Guidelines with regard to video recording and zoom photography.
- In order to control digital photographs, mobile phones may not be used in the changing village.
- No articles, periodicals, publications, flyers or goods of any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any persons save only the East District or SASA Ltd within events without the express written permission of the East District.
- Any person entering events must at all times comply with any and all instructions of any steward or officer of the East District and/or police officer. Failure to comply within a reasonable time with any such instruction will lead to the person being invited to leave.
- The East District reserves absolutely the right to eject from events any person failing to comply with each and all of the Event Regulations.
- Hot drinks are not allowed on poolside or in the spectator gallery.
