| EVENTS | 50m all strokes 4x25m mixed freestyle relays – 2 boys & 2 girls (any order) all age groups. All events are heat declared winners. It may be necessary to limit the number of heats in certain events. |
| AGE GROUPS | 8 years, 9 years, 10 years & 11 years – age on day of meet |
| SESSIONS | There will be 2 sessions as follows: Morning – warm up 9.00am session starts 9.30am Afternoon – warm up 2.00pm session starts 2.30pm |
| ENTRY FEES | £4 per individual event £7 per relay event Cheques should be made payable to Falkirk Otter ASC. |

| | Closing date for entries is midnight on Friday 28th March 2008 NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Rejected entries will be refunded in full. |
| OFFICIALS | Can each club supply at least 1 swimming technical official for each Session. Please advise names on gala entry form. |
| AWARDS | Medals will be presented to 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd places, pennants for 4 th , 5 th & 6 th places, with exception of relays where presentations will be for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd places. There will be awards for the top boy and girl in each age Group. The ‘Otter Trophy’ for the TOP CLUB will be presented to the club with the most points at the end of the day. Trophy to be returned after 1 year. Small trophy to be retained. |

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Meet to be held under SASA rules. Enclosed is a health and safety form to be completed (mandatory).**
- 2. All Swimmers of Scottish Clubs must have a S.A.S.A. registration number.**
- 3. No cards are required for this meet. Start sheets will be available to clubs prior to the start of each session.**
- 4. Electronic Timing will be in operation. In the event of electronic failure, back-up manual timing will be used.**
- 5. Withdrawals must be notified to the recorders no later than 20 minutes prior to the start of each session .**
- 6. Once start sheets have been prepared no alterations shall be made.**
- 7. It is the swimmers responsibility to check with the marshalls in the allocated area. Swimmers should report to the marshalls Four heats in advance of their race.**
- 8. Swimmers, coaches and team managers must ensure that all their swimmers can safely dive into the deep water as prescribed by current legislation. There will be no diving from the shallow end of the pool. During relays, starts from the shallow ends shall be from within the water.**
- 9. There will be a maximum of 2 no reserve swimmers for each event and no time only swims on the day. Would clubs also note that under no circumstances should any swimmer other than the one named on the start sheet go to the marshalling area.**
- 10. No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the meet organizers without prior approval of the meet director. Application must be made on the approved SASA form.**
- 11. Swimmers must act on the instructions given by the meet officials and behave in a reasonable manner at all times.**
- 12. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of meet rules.**
- 13. The Meet Management reserves the right to alter the programme and warm-up times if necessary. Anything not covered above or printed in the event programme will be at the promoter's discretion.**
- 14. The promoter's reserve the right to restrict entries in order to facilitate the smooth running of the meet. Entries will be accepted on time basis. Clubs should ensure entry times are accurate. Rejected entries will be refunded in full.**

MISCELLANEOUS

- There will be a Raffle, Tombola and Snack shop**
- Swimmers and Coaches must not take glassware into the showers or onto poolside otherwise they will be liable for expulsion from the meet.**
- Falkirk Otter ASC nor Larkhall Swimming pool can be held responsible for loss or damage to swimmer's, team staff or spectator's property. Swimmers are strongly advsed to secure property in the lockers provided in changing rooms and not to leave belongings lying around unattended.**
- Swimmers out with the pool side must wear dry clothing and footwear at all times.**
- Outdoor footwear must not be worn at poolside.**

HEALTH AND SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT

Controlling the Use of Photographic Equipment

Due to a warning received on paedophile activity the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association has decided that control of photographic equipment is required at all meets.

In view of this, the meet will run under the following guidelines:

- No photographic equipment (eg, Camera, Camcorder etc) is to be allowed on either poolside, spectator gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet director.
- Application to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved SASA form.
- Application can be made on the day to the meet director or to the meet directors appointed official. Applicant must provide proof of identity when applying and carry such proof when intending to use their photographic equipment.

In order to comply with accreditation and health and safety requirements, this form must be completed and returned along with entry information.
